

Comments:
 DPR uses all community center and APS facilities for programs and community groups.
 Centers do have standard operating hours, but often the facilities are kept open late or are forced to open early to accommodate programs.
 DPR must turn away potential users constantly because of limited space.
 If any availability exists in the centers, it is typically during the school day or a one-off (i.e., not a consistently available space, but during a break in classes/leagues).

These centers are used by DPR programs and external groups to run programs, meeting, or events. Many of these spaces have renovations/construction plans that will require DPR to relocate many programs into a smaller number of facilities including those already at capacity during peak times.
