- *Explore public-private projects with developers*
- *Consider joint facilities with nearby jurisdictions (D.C., Falls Church, Alexandria)*
- *Make better use of existing facility resources – ensure spaces are fully utilized*
- *Evolve public expectations of service planning & delivery*
- *Design in flexibility for multiple uses*
- *Address zoning barriers to creative solutions*
- *Use creative design to integrate “light industrial” uses into single-family neighborhoods*
