2.3 Annual integrated community-based employment conversation.

Historically, Community Service Board clientele have predominately been unemployed. In FY 2015 Virginia DBHDS adopted employment as a first choice discussion for individuals of employment age (18-67). 94% of individuals had integrated employment conversations FY 2016

3.1 Employment Goal on PCP Approximately 50% of the individuals receiving SC services are not interested in employment.

42% (77 of 183) of PCPs contain employment or employment readiness goals. The goal of 30% of PCPs containing employment or employment readiness goals was exceeded by 12%

- Critical to the data analysis is that 94 of 183(N) individuals are notinterested in pursuing work.
- Of the remaining 89 individuals who want to work (28) or continue working (49), 86% have employment or employment readiness goals.
